Request for Qualifications

Rolling Plains Management Corporation is currently requesting proposals from qualified individuals or companies to provide minor vehicle repair services on company fleet vehicles. Repairs requested but not limited to the following may include:

- Maintenance repairs such as alignments, tire rotation, balancing and brakes, batteries, hoses, wipers, lights and belts
- Replacement of minor mechanical parts such as but not limited to the following: alternators, fuel pumps, water-pumps, a/c service, and tune ups
- Any other minor mechanical repair or service not to exceed \$1500.00

Requirements

- Must have ASE or equivalent certification
- 3-5 years' mechanical experience
- Must have designated repair shop

Deadline for Submission

The deadline for submission of requests will be Friday September 28, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. RPMC specifically reserves the right to vary the provisions set forth herein any time prior to the execution of a contract where such variance is deemed to be in the best interest of the needs of RPMC.

If selected for negotiations, proposers may be required to prepare and submit additional information prior to final award is selection, in order to reach terms for the provisions of services, which are agreeable to both parties.

Modifications and Renewals

RPMC reserves the right to negotiate modifications or renewals in connection with any executed contract funded through this request without repeating process for a period of up to four (4) years additional years from the original proposal initiation.

Modifications and renewals shall be considered based upon the provider's ability to meet RPMC's needs.

Evolution Criteria

The selection of a proposal is to be made after a careful evaluation of prevailing prices in the area of the proposals received. The successful vendor must be responsive to the terms of the proposal and must demonstrate that he/she is a responsible bidder.

- a) A responsible vendor is one who submits a complete proposal within the stated time in accordance with the proposal.
- b) A responsible vendor is one who demonstrates, via his or her response to the selection criteria, his or her ability to deliver the services solicited for procurement.

Selection of a vendor will include the consideration of proposed cost; the ability to offer services requested.

Submission Requirements

The bid should contain the following:

- Individual and /or company name, address, and phone
- Summary of experience
- Other information pertinent to your qualifications (certifications)
- Diagnostic service cost
- Hourly rate of services
